

# TICKETS FOR BUS AND TRAIN TRAVEL

(Updated Feb 2015)

## **South Yorkshire Senior Citizen passes**

South Yorkshire Senior Citizen Free Concessionary pass holders can travel free on buses in England and on the Sheffield Super Tram between 09:30 and 23:00 Monday to Friday and all day on Saturday, Sunday & Bank Holidays. The pass can also be used before 09:30 and after 23:00 on Monday to Friday for a fare of £1 on all buses operated by TM Travel.

The pass can also be used on trains within South Yorkshire only for a half price fare single or day return between 09:30 and 23:00 Monday to Friday and all day on Saturday, Sunday & Bank Holidays. Half price travel is available between Sheffield and: Dore & Totley; Barnsley/Darton/Penistone/Denby Dale; Rotherham/Moorthorpe; Doncaster/South Elmsall/Thorne North/Thorne South; Kiveton Park.

### **Train restriction**

On Northern Rail trains off peak return tickets are not valid for trains scheduled to depart between 4.01pm and 6.29pm on weekdays.

#### **1. South Yorkshire Connect**

ADULT        £6.20

#### **Validity**

All buses and the Super Tram, All day any day within South Yorkshire.

#### **Where to buy**

Tickets can be bought from the driver on most buses and on the Super Tram.

#### **2. South Yorkshire Travel Master Gold Day**

ADULT        £7.50

#### **Validity**

Any bus, tram or train within South Yorkshire all day any day.

#### **Where to buy**

The ticket can be bought from SYPTE Travel Centres or any staffed railway stations in South Yorkshire at time of travel.

#### **3. Sheffield City Wide Day Ticket**

ADULT        £4.50

#### **Validity**

This ticket can be used on all buses and tram within the Sheffield City Council area

#### **Where to buy**

Tickets can be bought from the driver on most buses and on the Super Tram.

### **NOTES**

- a) All South Yorkshire and Sheffield tickets can be used to Fox House, Toads Mouth, Moscar and Owler Bar on bus services into Derbyshire.
- b) Weekly, 28 day and annual tickets are available for Travel Master and City Wide tickets

#### **4. TM Travel Day Rover**

ADULT £6.50

##### **Validity**

This ticket gives unlimited travel on all services run by TM Travel, including routes 65, 215 and 218 from Sheffield into the Peak District.

#### **5. First and Stagecoach tickets**

Both companies have their own day, weekly and monthly tickets for use on their own services only. See leaflets from the companies or consult their websites.

#### **6. Derbyshire Wayfarer (Day tickets)**

<b>Ticket type</b>	<b>Price</b>
ADULT + 1 CHILD AGED 5 – 15	£12.00
ADULT CONCESSIONARY* + 1 CHILD AGED 5 – 15	£6.00

\* Aged 60 and over. No OAP bus pass necessary to purchase this ticket.

##### **Validity**

**BUSES** All buses in Derbyshire and on all services into Derbyshire from various places outside the county, including Sheffield.

**TRAINS** After 9 am on Monday to Friday and all day Saturday, Sunday and

Bank Holidays on the following lines:

SHEFFIELD – DERBY – LONG EATON;

SHEFFIELD – ALFRETON – LANGLEY MILL;

SHEFFIELD – DERBY – BURTON ON TRENT;

SHEFFIELD – EDALE – NEW MILLS (CENTRAL);

NEW MILLS (NEWTOWN) – BUXTON;

DERBY – UTTOXETER;

DERBY – BELPER – MATLOCK;

SHIREBROOK WHITWELL (on Worksop to Nottingham line).

##### **Where to buy**

Tickets can be bought from SYPTE Travel Centres in Sheffield, tourist information centres in Derbyshire, Sheffield Railway Station, staffed railway stations in Derbyshire and from drivers of certain companies buses (see leaflet for details).

THESE TICKETS CANNOT BE BOUGHT ON TRAINS.

#### Validity

**BUSES** All day on buses in Greater Manchester and to many places in Derbyshire and surrounding counties, including Fox House and Owl Bar on services into Sheffield.

**TRAINS** All Trains in Greater Manchester & Metrolink Tram after 9.30 am on Monday to Friday and all day Saturday, Sunday and Bank Holidays Also on trains from Manchester to: GRINDLEFORD (on Sheffield line); BUXTON; HOLMES CHAPEL (on Crewe line); NORTHWICH; WARRINGTON (BANK QUAY & CENTRAL); BRYN (on Liverpool line); ORRELL; PARBOLD (on Southport line); CHORLEY (on Preston line); DARWEN; LITTLEBOROUGH; GREENFIELD; HADFIELD; GLOSSOP.

#### Where to buy

Tickets can be bought from the conductor on Hope Valley line trains (valid from Grindleford onwards). They can also be bought at Buxton and New Mills Central (ticket office only staffed for part of each day), at all staffed stations within the area covered by the ticket, at GMPTE travel .

**8. Hope Valley Tickets**

- a) Return tickets issued on services 272 to Hathersage, Bamford, Hope or Castleton can be used to return by train.
- b) Return tickets issued on the train can be used to return by bus.
- c) Return tickets issued on Hulleys services or on TM services 273, 274 and 275 can be used to return by service 272 and vice versa.
- d) Return tickets issued by any operator on all the above services are valid on any bus serving the Hope Valley and on trains from Hathersage, Bamford and Hope railway stations.

**Example Fares on First bus on service 272**

SHEFFIELD to HATHERSAGE	£3.00 single, £5.00 return
SHEFFIELD to CASTLETON	£3.50 single, £6.00 return
